## NOTICE TO LPG, CNG AND LNG OPERATORS

## Transport Waiver for Alternative Fuels

The ongoing winter storm affecting Texas has increased the need for the transportation of alternative fuels in Texas. The alternative fuels regulated by the Railroad Commission of Texas (RRC) are Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG, LP-Gas Propane), Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) and Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG). Pursuant to the disaster declaration issued by the Office of the Governor of February 12<sup>th</sup>, 2021, the Office of the Governor has waived RRC enforcement of certain statutes and rules relating to the transport of alternative fuels. Pursuant to the Governor's waiver and in an effort to proactively mitigate the potential increase in demand for the transportation of alternative fuels, RRC is waiving the requirements for companies to have a license for the transportation of alternative fuels and the registration of units transporting alternative fuels in Texas. All transport units must meet US DOT regulations and must meet the minimum insurance requirements in Texas Administrative Code Chapters 9, 13 and 14, as applicable, to qualify for the waiver. The waiver will remain in effect until March 2, 2021 unless terminated sooner by the Office of the Governor.
