**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF  
ENERGY TRANSFER COMPANY  
TO CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE  
A HYDROGEN SULFIDE GAS PIPELINE  
CHEYENNE PIPELINE  
TILDEN GATHERING SYSTEM  
LA SALLE & MCMULLEN COUNTIES, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket reviewed on August 29, 2011, the reviewing examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Energy Transfer Company to construct and operate a hydrogen sulfide gas pipeline, a 6<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub> inch gathering line from the Irving Family Trust Unit B Well site to the West Big Foot Lateral, McMullen County, Texas, is hereby approved. Energy Transfer Company shall comply with all applicable rules and safety standards adopted by the Commission for the construction and operation of the hydrogen sulfide gas pipelines.
