FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF EOG RESOURCES, INC.  
TO CONSTRUCT A SOUR GAS PIPELINE, PEELER GATHERING SYSTEM,  
ATASCOSA AND MCMULLEN COUNTIES, TEXAS


The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket reviewed on February 20, 2014, the reviewing examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of EOG Resources, Inc., to construct and operate 29.98 miles of new 12-inch hydrogen sulfide gas pipeline in the Peeler Gathering System, Eagleville (Eagle Ford-1) Field, Atascosa and McMullen Counties, Texas, is hereby approved. The new construction pipeline segments along with the existing Peeler Gathering System will gather sour gas from acreage being developed by EOG Resources, Inc., and transport it to third-party pipelines operated by Regency and Enterprise. EOG Resources, Inc., shall comply with all applicable rules and safety standards adopted by the Commission for the construction and operation of hydrogen sulfide gas pipelines.
