**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF
XTO ENERGY INC.
TO CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE A HYDROGEN SULPHIDE GAS PIPELINE
AN EXTENSION OF THE TEAGUE SOUR GAS GATHERING SYSTEM
THE N.E. TEAGUE 8" LOOP LINE
FREESTONE COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket reviewed on June 9, 2005, the reviewing examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of XTO Energy Inc. to construct and operate a hydrogen sulphide gas pipeline extension, N.E. Teague 8" Loop Line connecting and discharging gas from the N.E. Teague Compressor Station to either the Teague Townsite Amine Plant or the Fails-Eubanks Paques Plant, in the Teague Field Area of Freestone County, Texas, is hereby approved. XTO Energy Inc. shall comply with all applicable rules and safety standards adopted by the Commission for the construction and operation of the hydrogen sulphide gas pipelines.
