FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF TREND GATHERING & TREATING, LP  
TO CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE A HYDROGEN SULFIDE GAS PIPELINE,  
THE 8-INCH ORAND "A" 7 TO ORAND "A" 2  
IN THE NORTH REED GATHERING SYSTEM  
FREESTONE COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket reviewed on June 16, 2012, the reviewing examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

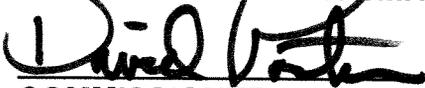
The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Trend Gathering & Treating, LP to construct and operate a hydrogen sulfide gas pipeline to transport produced gas from the Orand "A" 7 and Orand "A" 2 gas wells to the 8-inch Orand "A"7 and Orand "A"2 sour gas pipeline in the North Reed Gathering System, Freestone County, Texas, is hereby approved. Trend Gathering & Treating, LP shall comply with all applicable rules and safety standards adopted by the Commission for the construction and operation of hydrogen sulfide gas pipelines.

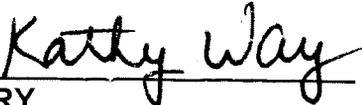
