**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF TARGA MIDSTREAM RESOURCES, LLC
TO CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE A HYDROGEN SULFIDE GAS PIPELINE,
THE XTO MONUMENT INTERCONNECT PIPELINE

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket reviewed on February 15, 2013, the reviewing examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.


Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Targa Midstream Resources, LLC to construct and operate a hydrogen sulfide gas pipeline to transport produced gas to the 8-inch XTO Monument Interconnect sour gas pipeline in the Cornell Field area, Gaines County, Texas, is hereby approved. Targa Midstream Resources, LLC shall comply with all applicable rules and safety standards adopted by the Commission for the construction and operation of hydrogen sulfide gas pipelines.


