**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF CAPACITY EXEMPT ALLOWABLE
FOR EMBAR (PERMIAN) FIELD
ANDREWS COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on December 22, 2005, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of ConocoPhillips Company for capacity exempt allowable for the Ember (Permian) Field, Andrews County, Texas, be and it is hereby approved. The daily allowable production of oil from individual wells completed in the field shall not be subject to oil allowable proration or gas limit restriction and said allowables shall be set at capacity/exempt.

It is further ordered that all overproduction for the subject field is hereby canceled.
