**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING INCREASED NET GAS-OIL RATIO AUTHORITY
FOR EACH WELL ON THE J. E. BARNES LEASE
BIG MINERAL CREEK (WOODFORD) FIELD
GRAYSON COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on January 7, 2011, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that each well on the J. E. Barnes Lease (ID No. 31600) in the Big Mineral Creek (Woodford) Field, Grayson County, Texas, is hereby granted permission to produce under increased net gas-oil ratio authority with a casinghead gas limit of 600 MCFGPD.

It is further **ORDERED** that each well's oil allowable shall not be penalized unless the above permitted casinghead gas limit is exceeded.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction on the J. E. Barnes Lease in the Big Mineral Creek (Woodford) Field is hereby cancelled.
