**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF FAMCOR OIL, INC.  
FOR EXCEPTION TO 16 TAC §3.32 FOR THE  
KNIGHT LEASE, WELL NO. 1  
BIG SANDY (COCKFIELD) FIELD  
POLK COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on August 08, 2012, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Famcor Oil, Inc. is hereby granted an exception to 16 TAC §3.32 for the Knight Lease, Well No. 1 (API No. 42-373-31167), in the Big Sandy (Cockfield) Field, Polk County, Texas. Famcor Oil, Inc. is authorized to flare up to 400 MCFGPD in its Knight Lease, Well No. 1, from March 20, 2012 through July 30, 2012. The authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall file for each well the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
