**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF OCCIDENTAL PERMIAN LTD. FOR  
INJECTION OF FLUIDS CONTAINING HYDROGEN SULFIDE IN THE  
SOUTHEAST LEVELLAND UNIT  
LEVELLAND FIELD  
HOCKLEY COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on September 7, 2010, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Occidental Permian Ltd. is hereby authorized to inject fluids containing hydrogen sulfide into 38 injection wells (Nos. 4W, 5W, 6A1, 9W, 10W, 11W, 12W, 33W, 104W, 105W, 107W, 108W, 109W, 115W, 117W, 118W, 119W, 120W, 121W, 122W, 152W, 153W, 154W, 155W, 204, 211, 212, 213, 216, 217W, 218W, 320W, 321W, 356W, 357, 358, 359 and 365) on the Southeast Levelland Unit (Lease Id. No. 18515), Levelland Field, Hockley County, Texas, pursuant to Statewide Rule 36(c)(10)(A)(ii).
