On February 16, 2011, protestants Ms. Lura Daussat and Ms. Rachelle Ivanova each filed an appeal pursuant to 16 TEX. ADMIN. CODE §1.30(c)(2) of the hearing examiner's interim ruling which denied said protestants' request to appear telephonically at the above-captioned hearing.


Having considered the pleadings of the parties and the examiner's report, the Commission has determined that the appeal is without merit and the hearing examiner's interim ruling should be affirmed, as consistent with Rule 1.130, which disallows telephonic hearings without all parties' consent.





