**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF
EOG RESOURCES, INC.
FOR MER ALLOWABLE FOR THE
SHANNON HOSPITAL 4 #3 UNIT LEASE WELL NO. 3
NOELKE (WOLFCAMP, LOWER) FIELD
CROCKETT COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on June 30, 2006, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of EOG Resources, Inc. be and is hereby approved to allow the Shannon Hospital 4 #3 Unit Lease (No. 15783) Well No. 3, in the Noelke (Wolfcamp, Lower) Field, Crockett County, Texas, to produce up to 700 barrels of oil per day.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for the EOG Resources, Inc. Shannon Hospital 4 #3 Unit Lease, in the Noelke (Wolfcamp, Lower) Field, be and is hereby canceled as of the date of the Final Order.
