**FINAL ORDER  
CONSOLIDATING THE LEONA RIVER (OLMOS SECOND) FIELD  
INTO THE LEONA RIVER (OLMOS) FIELD  
AND RESCINDING FIELD RULES FOR THE LEONA RIVER (OLMOS) FIELD  
ZAVALA COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on May 3, 2001, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the Leona River (Olmos Second) Field is hereby consolidated into the Leona River (Olmos) Field. It is further ordered that field rules adopted on October 15, 1952 for the Leona River (Olmos) Field are hereby rescinded.
