**FINAL ORDER
CONSOLIDATING THE KASPAR, S. (KASPAR) AND
KASPAR (LOWER WILCOX, RYNE) FIELDS
INTO THE KASPAR, S. (KNAVE) FIELD AND AMENDING FIELD RULES
FOR THE KASPAR, S. (KNAVE) FIELD
DEWITT COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on February 27, 2001, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Coastal Oil & Gas Corp. to consolidate the Kaspar, S. (Kaspar) and Kaspar (Lower Wilcox, Ryne) Fields into the Kaspar, S. (Knavé) Field, DeWitt County, be and is hereby approved.

It is further **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Rule 1 for the Kaspar, S. (Knavé) Field, adopted under Final Order No. 02-0200616, effective February 1, 1993, be and it is amended as hereafter set out.

RULE 1: The entire correlative interval from 12,950 to 14,860 feet as shown on the Induction-Gamma Ray log of the Coastal Oil & Gas Corp. Matocha Garrett Lease, Well No. 1; Jesse Beeson Survey, DeWitt County, Texas, shall be designated as a single reservoir for proration purposes and be designated as the Kaspar, S. (Knavé) Field.
