**FINAL ORDER
CONSOLIDATING VARIOUS FIELDS INTO
THE BETHANY (TRAVIS PEAK CONS.) FIELD AND
AMENDING FIELD RULES FOR THE
BETHANY (TRAVIS PEAK CONS.) FIELD
PANOLA AND HARRISON COUNTIES, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on January 22, 2008, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the following fields located in Panola and Harrison Counties, Texas, are hereby combined into the Bethany (Travis Peak Cons.) Field:

It is further ordered that Rule 1 of the field rules adopted in Oil and Gas Docket No. 06-0252074, effective September 11, 2007, for the Bethany (Travis Peak Cons.) Field, is amended as hereafter set out:

RULE 1: The entire correlative interval between 5,798 feet and 7,858 feet, as shown on the log of the Texaco E & P Inc. - G. W. Brumble G.U. No. 1 Well No. 3, API 365 32847, E Brackin Survey, A-75, Panola County, shall be designated as a single reservoir for proration purposes and be designated as the Bethany (Travis Peak Cons.) Field.

It is further ordered that the field shall be classified as associated-prorated and the allocation formula shall remain suspended pursuant to Statewide Rule 31(j). Oil wells in the field shall be allowed to produce under increased net gas-oil ratio authority with a casinghead gas limit of 1,500 MCFD. No well shall have its oil allowable penalized unless the above permitted casinghead gas limit is exceeded.

Wells in the subject fields shall be transferred into the Bethany (Travis Peak Cons.) Field without requiring new drilling permits.
