**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF HILCORP ENERGY COMPANY  
FOR INCREASED CASINGHEAD GAS WITHDRAWALS  
LAKE PASTURE (H-440) FIELD  
REFUGIO COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on April 7, 2010, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission that the maximum daily withdrawal of gas from the Lake Pasture (H-440) Field, Refugio County, Texas, shall be 8,400 MCFD. Hilcorp Energy Company wells will be allowed to produce up to 5,460 MCF per day while T-C Oil Company wells will be allowed to produce up to 2,940 MCF per day.

It is further **ORDERED** that Rule 8 of the field rules for the Lake Pasture (H-440) Field authorizing a permissible gas-oil ratio of 231 cubic feet per barrel, is hereby rescinded.
