**AMENDING RULE 1 OF THE FIELD RULES
ADOPTED IN FINAL ORDER NO. 04-0219348, ISSUED EFFECTIVE JULY 31, 1998
FOR THE ANN MAG, EAST (L. VX BLAINEY SD) FIELD
BROOKS COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on February 27, 2001, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** that Rule 1 of the field rules adopted in Final Order No. 4-0219348, issued effective July 31, 1998, for the Ann Mag, East (L. Vx Blainey SD) Field, Brooks County, Texas, be amended as hereafter set out.

RULE 1: The entire correlative interval from 11,045 feet to 11,956 feet as shown on the Dual Induction Focused log of the Maguire Oil Company Sullivan Deep 'A' Well No. 1, "El Tule" Antonio Garcia Survey, Brooks County, Texas, shall be designated as a single reservoir for proration purposes and be designated as the Ann Mag, East (L. Vx. Blainey SD) Field.
