**FINAL ORDER  
AMENDING RULE 1  
FOR THE NUECES BAY DEEP CONSOLIDATED FIELD,  
SAN PATRICIO COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on November 14, 2008, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered that field rules adopted in Final Order No. 04-0219171, effective June 2, 1998, for the Nueces Bay Deep Consolidated Field, San Patricio County, Texas, are hereby amended as follows:

**RULE 1:** The entire combined correlative interval from 9,590 feet TVD and 11,880 feet TVD as shown on the HD Induction and Gamma Ray log of the EOG Resources, Inc., State Tract 690/745 & 750 GU Well No. 2 (API No. 42-409-32897), J. N. Seguin Survey, A-246, San Patricio County, Texas shall be designated as a single reservoir for proration purposes and be designated as the Nueces Bay Deep Consolidated Field.
