EXAMINER'S REPORT AND RECOMMENDATION

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Forest Oil Corporation requests that field rules be adopted for the Jewett (Travis Peak) Field. The proposed rules are summarized as follows:

1. Designation of the field as the correlative interval from 9,824 feet to 12,390 feet as shown on the log of the M. E. Garrett No. 1;
2. 467'-600' well spacing;
3. 40 acre/optional 20 acre density;
4. Allocation based on 50% acreage and 50% deliverability, with AOF status.

This application was unopposed and the examiner recommends that the rules proposed by Forest Oil Corporation be adopted on a permanent basis for the Jewett (Travis Peak) Field.

DISCUSSION OF EVIDENCE

The Jewett (Travis Peak) Field was discovered in 1973. The field is classified as non-associated and is AOF status. There are 30 producing wells on the current proration schedule. Forest Oil Corporation operates more than half of the wells in the field.
