**FINAL ORDER  
AMENDING FIELD RULE NO. 1 FOR THE  
DEW (C.V. CONSOLIDATED) FIELD  
FREESTONE COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on September 10, 2012, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Field Rule No. 1 of the Field Rules adopted in Final Order No. 05-0229554, effective December 04, 2001, as amended, for the DEW (C.V. Consolidated) Field, Freestone County, Texas is amended as hereafter set out:

**RULE 1:** The entire correlative interval from from 10,700 feet to 13,775 feet, as shown on the log of the William C. Glazener #1 (API No. 42-161-30726), Durham Avant Survey, A-3, Freestone County, Texas, shall be designated as a single reservoir for proration purposes and be designated as the DEW (C.V. Consolidated) Field.
