**FINAL ORDER
AMENDING RULE 1 OF THE FIELD RULES
ADOPTED IN FINAL ORDER NO. 7C-0213192
ISSUED EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 10, 1996, AS AMENDED,
FOR THE GEASLIN (WOLFCAMP) FIELD
TERRELL COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on April 20, 2006, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, and the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Rule 1 of the field rules adopted in Final Order No. 7C-0213192, issued effective October 10, 1996, as amended, for the Geaslin (Wolfcamp) Field, Terrell County, Texas, be and it is amended as hereafter set out.

RULE 1: The entire correlative interval with a top shown at 3104 feet on the neutron-density log of the Brown NE 213 Lease, Well No. 41 (API No. 443-31143), Section 213; and at 2500 feet on the neutron-density log of the Geaslin 198 Lease, Well No. 1 (API No. 443-30554), Section 198, both in Block Y, T.J. McLaughlin Survey, A-902; and a base at 8000 feet as shown on the neutron-density log of the Geaslin 198 Lease, Well No. 1, Section 198, Block Y, T.J. McLaughlin Survey, A-902; in Terrell County, Texas, shall be designated as a single reservoir for proration purposes and be designated as the Geaslin (Wolfcamp) Field.
