**FINAL ORDER  
AMENDING FIELD RULE 4 AND DELETING FIELD RULE 5 FOR THE  
FUHRMAN-MASCHO FIELD  
ANDREWS, ECTOR AND MIDLAND COUNTIES, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on May 30, 2008, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Rule 4 of the Special Field Rules adopted in Final Order No. 8-6737, issued effective September 25, 1944, as amended, for the Fuhrman-Mascho Field, Andrews, Ector and Midland Counties, Texas is amended as hereafter set out:

**RULE 4:** The field is classified as salvage with no restriction on oil or casinghead gas.

It is further ordered that Rule 5 is hereby deleted and all other existing rules remain unchanged.

It is further ordered that all accumulated overproduction in the Fuhrman-Mascho Field is cancelled.
