ORDER NUNC PRO TUNC

ORDER APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF
MAK-J ENERGY PARTNERS (TX), LTD.,
TO ADOPT FIELD RULES FOR THE PETTY 48 (UPPER STRAWN)
HOWARD COUNTY, TEXAS

In conference at its office in Austin, Texas the Railroad Commission of Texas took up for consideration the matter of correcting its Final Order entered on September 13, 2011, adopting field rules for the Petty 48 (Upper Strawn) Field in Howard County, Texas. The Commission finds that, due to clerical error, the Final Order entered September 13, 2011, erroneously adopted the correlative interval from 9,789 feet to 9,930 feet, as shown on the log of the Mak-J Energy Partners, O'Brien "43" lease, Well No. 1 (API No. 42-317-35492).

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that the Final Order in Docket No. 08-0271143 be, and the same is hereby, amended *nunc pro tunc* so that the correlative interval initially adopted on April 29, 1997, in Final Order No. 08-0215285 for the Petty 48 (Upper Strawn) Field, remain in effect and Rule 1 correctly reads as follows:

RULE 1: The entire correlative interval from 9,627 feet to 9,640 feet, as shown on the Schlumberger Phasor Induction gamma Ray Litho Density Compensated Neutron Microlog/NGT log of the Cobra Oil and Gas Corporation, Petty Unit 48, Well No. 1, in the Bauer & Cockrell Survey, Section 48, Block A, Howard County Texas, shall be designated as a single reservoir for proration purposes and shall be designated as the Petty 48 (Upper Strawn) Field.
