**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF ACCESS MLP OPERATING LLC  
TO CONSTRUCT A SOUR GAS PIPELINE FACILITY  
FAUST INTERCONNECT,  
DIMMIT COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket reviewed on April 22, 2014, the reviewing examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the Findings of Fact Nos. 1, 2, and 4 through 9, and all Conclusions of Law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein. Further, the Commission adopts a replacement to Finding of Fact No. 3, correcting the pipeline length and connections, presented in its entirety below:

**Replacement Finding of Fact**


3. Access proposes construction of a 1.126 mile pipeline connecting to the Faust and Anderson Stone lateral pipelines.
  - a. The pipeline will be 10 3/4 inches in diameter and 1.126 miles in length.
  - b. The pipeline will carry a maximum of 12.5 MMCFGPD containing up to 10,000 parts per million (ppm) of H<sub>2</sub>S.
  - c. The maximum operating pressure will be 720 psig.


Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Access MLP Operating LLC to construct and operate a sour gas pipeline, the Faust Interconnect, in Dimmitt County, Texas, is hereby approved. Access MLP Operating LLC shall comply with all applicable rules and safety standards adopted by the Commission for the construction and operation of hydrogen sulfide gas pipelines.


