FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF CHESAPEAKE MIDSTREAM DEVELOPMENT, LP.
TO CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE A HYDROGEN SULFIDE GAS PIPELINE
JJ HENRY LATERAL, FOX CREEK GAS GATHERING SYSTEM
MCMULLEN COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket reviewed on August 02, 2011, the reviewing examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Chesapeake Midstream Development, LP to construct and operate a hydrogen sulfide gas pipeline, a 8 5/8" gas gathering pipeline to transport produced gas from the JJ Henry 2B H Well location the JJ Henry Lateral in the Fox Creek Gas Gathering System Area, McMullen County, Texas, is hereby approved. Chesapeake Midstream Development, LP shall comply with all applicable rules and safety standards adopted by the Commission for the construction and operation of hydrogen sulfide gas pipelines.


