**FINAL ORDER  
ESTABLISHING THE MOST EFFICIENT RATE OF PRODUCTION  
AND AMENDING FIELD RULE 3  
FOR THE MILLS RANCH (GRANITE WASH CONS) FIELD  
WHEELER COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on April 25, 2013, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the most efficient rate of production at the current time for the each horizontal well (stacked lateral or single lateral) in the Mills Ranch (Granite Wash Cons) Field is 5,000 BOPD. It is further ordered that all overproduction in the Mills Ranch (Granite Wash Cons) Field is hereby canceled.

It is further ORDERED by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Field Rule 3 shall be amended for the Mills Ranch (Granite Wash Cons) Field, Wheeler County, Texas as follows:

**RULE 3a:** The acreage assigned to the individual oil well for the purpose of allocating allowable oil production thereto shall be known as a proration unit. The standard drilling and proration units are established hereby to be ONE HUNDRED SIXTY (160) acres. No proration unit shall consist of more than ONE HUNDRED SIXTY (160) acres except as hereinafter provided. All proration units shall consist of continuous and contiguous acreage which can reasonably be considered to be productive of oil. No double assignment of acreage will be accepted.

If after the drilling of the last well on any lease and the assignment of acreage to each well thereon in accordance with the regulations of the Commission there remains an additional unassigned acreage of less than ONE HUNDRED SIXTY (160) acres, then and in such event the remaining unassigned acreage up to and including a total of FORTY (40) acres may be assigned as tolerance acreage to the last well drilled on such lease or may

be distributed among any group of wells located thereon, so long as the proration units resulting from the inclusion of such additional acreage meet the limitations prescribed by the Commission.

An operator, at his option, shall be permitted to form optional oil units of TWENTY (20) acres, with a proportional acreage allowable credit for a well on fractional proration units.

**RULE 3b:** The acreage assigned to the individual gas well for the purpose of allocating allowable gas production thereto shall be known as a proration unit. The standard drilling and proration units are established hereby to be ONE HUNDRED SIXTY (160) acres. No proration unit shall consist of more than ONE HUNDRED SIXTY (160) acres; provided that, tolerance acreage of ten (10) percent shall be allowed for each standard proration unit so that an amount not to exceed a maximum of ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY SIX (176) acres may be assigned. Each proration unit containing less than ONE HUNDRED SIXTY (160) acres shall be a fractional proration unit. All proration units shall consist of continuous and contiguous acreage which can reasonably be considered to be productive of gas. No double assignment of acreage will be accepted.

An operator, at his option, shall be permitted to form optional gas units of TWENTY (20) acres, with a proportional acreage allowable credit for a well on fractional proration units.

For the determination of acreage credit in this field, operators shall file for each oil or gas well in this field a Form P-15 Statement of Productivity of Acreage Assigned to Proration Units. On that form or an attachment thereto, the operator shall list the number of acres that are being assigned to each well on the lease or unit for proration purposes, in lieu of amended Form P-15's. For oil or gas wells, operators shall be required to file, along with the Form P-15, a plat of the lease, unit or property; provided that operators shall not be required to show individual proration units on such plat. Operators may, however, file such proration unit plats for individual wells in the field if they so choose.
