**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF  
JUNO OPERATING COMPANY II, LLC  
FOR DESIGNATION OF ITS CLARK WOOD RANCH (LEASE ID NO. 69994)  
AS AN ENTITY FOR DENSITY PURPOSES  
HOOPLE (CLEAR FORK) FIELD  
LUBBOCK COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on April 2, 2014, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the Juno Operating Company II, LLC, Clark Wood Ranch (Lease ID No. 69994) Lease shall be treated as an entity for density in the following field:

The approval of the Clark Wood Ranch Lease as an entity for density is subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. Wells on the Clark Wood Ranch Lease will be drilled and operated in compliance with the applicable lease line spacing rule unless exception is granted after notice and opportunity for hearing.
2. The between-wells spacing rule will be suspended so long as the Clark Wood Ranch Lease is developed with not more than one producing well for each 10 acres of such Lease.

3. The Clark Wood Ranch Lease's well density shall not exceed that authorized by applicable Field Rules, unless exception is granted after notice and opportunity for hearing. So long as the Clark Wood Ranch Lease is developed with not more than one producing well for each 10 acres of such Lease, the requirement for filing individual well Forms P-15 and proration unit plats is suspended.
4. Except as otherwise provided herein, all wells on the Clark Wood Ranch lease shall comply with all other applicable Field Rules for the Hoople (Clear Fork) Field.
