ORDER NUNC PRO TUNC

**THE APPLICATION OF PIONEER NATURAL RES. USA, INC.
TO CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE A HYDROGEN SULFIDE GAS PIPELINE,
THE WASHBURN 01-08, 09, 10, 11, 12, AND 13H, 8-INCH SOUR GAS PIPELINE,
LA SALLE COUNTY, TEXAS**

In conference at its office in Austin, Texas, the Railroad Commission of Texas took up for consideration its Final Order entered on June 17, 2014, the Application of Pioneer Natural Resources, USA, Inc. to Construct and Operate a Hydrogen Sulfide Gas Pipeline, the Washburn 01-08, 09, 10, and 11H, 8-inch Sour Gas Pipeline, in La Salle County, Texas. The Commission finds that the Final Order entered June 17, 2014, omitted the Applicant's prior request to amend the name of the pipeline to "The Washburn 01-08, 09, 10, 11, 12, and 13H" lateral, indicating that the pipeline would also transport sour gas from the 12H and 13H wells.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that the Final Order in Docket No. 01-0287608 be, and the same is hereby, amended *nunc pro tunc* so that the order contains the correct lateral name and the order now reads as follows:

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Pioneer Natural Res. USA, Inc. to construct and operate a hydrogen sulfide gas pipeline, an 8-inch gas gathering pipeline to transport produced gas from the Washburn 02 Well Nos. 08, 09, 10, 11, 12, and 13H, to the Lateral East 12-inch gathering line in La Salle County, Texas, is hereby approved. Pioneer Natural Res. USA, Inc. shall comply with all applicable rules and safety standards adopted by the Commission for the construction and operation of hydrogen sulfide gas pipelines.
