**FINAL ORDER  
FOR AN EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32  
FOR FOR VARIOUS TANK BATTERIES,  
WOLFBONE (TREND AREA) FIELD,  
REEVES COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on October 29, 2014, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and proposal for decision, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that COG Operating LLC is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the following tank batteries in the Wolfbone (Trend Area) Field in Reeves County, Texas:

- Big Lub Tank Battery (Permit No. 16096), COG is authorized to flare 165 MCF/D casinghead gas for one year from September 12, 2014 through September 11, 2015.
- Cowboy Tank Battery (Permit No. 16055), COG is authorized to flare 1,868 MCF/D casinghead gas for one year from September 12, 2014 through September 11, 2015.
- Dutch State 24 Tank Battery (Permit No. 17011), COG is authorized to flare 133 MCF/D casinghead gas for one year from November 1, 2014, through October 31, 2015.
- IKE State Tank Battery (Permit No. 14860), COG is authorized to flare 1,011 MCF/D casinghead gas for one year from September 12, 2014 through September 11, 2015.
- Tycoon Tank Battery (Permit No. 15247), COG is authorized to flare 1,000 MCF/D casinghead gas for one year from September 12, 2014 through September 11, 2015.

This authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms. The operator shall file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee for the well.
