FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF
ACCESS MLP OPERATING, LLC
TO CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE A SOUR GAS PIPELINE
THE 16-INCH TRUNKLINE,
LA SALLE COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket reviewed on December 19, 2014, the reviewing examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Access MLP Operating, LLC, to construct and operate a hydrogen sulfide gas pipeline, the 16-inch Trunkline (Beginning Point: 28 30.01, -99 19.15; Ending Point 28 33.8, -99 21.4 - North American Datum 83), La Salle County, Texas, is hereby APPROVED. Access MLP Operating, LLC, shall comply with all applicable rules and safety standards adopted by the Commission for the construction and operation of hydrogen sulfide gas pipelines.
