**FINAL ORDER
APPLICATION OF DALLAS PRODUCTION, INC.
TO SUSPEND THE ALLOCATION FORMULA
PURSUANT TO STATEWIDE RULE 31
FOR THE J.V.T. (CONGL. 4250) FIELD
PALO PINTO COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on December 15, 2014, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the allocation formula in the J.V.T. (Congl. 4250) Field is hereby suspended. The allocation formula may be reinstated administratively. While the allocation formula is suspended, if, for any month, the market demand for gas production from a well in the J.V.T. (Congl. 4250) Field falls below 100% of deliverability, as determined by the deliverability tests on file with the Commission, the Commission must be notified pursuant to Statewide Rule 31(j).
