FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF LINN OPERATING, INC.
FOR A FIELD-WIDE MAXIMUM EFFICIENT RATE ALLOWABLE,
NET GAS-OIL RATIO, EXCEPTION TO RULE 49(A),
AND CANCELLATION OF OVERPRODUCTION FOR THE
GOLDSMITH (CLEAR FORK) FIELD,
ECTOR COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on October 30, 2014, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that all wells in the Goldsmith (Clear Fork) Field, Ector County, Texas, may be produced under a Maximum Efficient Rate allowable of 500 BOPD and a Daily Gas Limit of 1,000 MCFD.

It is further **ORDERED** that all wells in the Goldsmith (Clear Fork) Field shall no longer be subject to a Statewide Rule 49(a) limitation.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction in the Louisa Lease (No. 43140), Isabel Lease (42435), and Vivian Lease (41959), in the Goldsmith (Clear Fork) Field is hereby cancelled.
