**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF
MURPHY EXPLORATION & PRODUCTION CO - USA, FOR AN
EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32 GAS FLARING,
FOR THE PENNINGTON UNIT, WELL NO. 1H AND WILLIAMS UNIT, WELL NO. 1H
EAGLEVILLE (EAGLE FORD-1) FIELD,
ATASCOSA COUNTY, TEXAS, AND THE KBS CENTRAL FACILITY, BRISCOE
RANCH (EAGLE FORD) FIELD, DIMMIT COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on August 15, 2015, the presiding Examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and proposal for decision, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Murphy Exploration & Production Co - USA is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the Pennington Unit, Well No. 1H and Williams Unit, Well No. 1H Eagleville (Eagle Ford - 1) Field in Atascosa County, Texas, and for the KBS Central Facility, Briscoe Ranch (Eagle Ford) Field in Dimmit County, Texas. Murphy Exploration & Production Co - USA is authorized to flare up to 140MCF/D of casinghead gas for the Pennington Unit and up to 230 MCF/D for the Williams Unit from July 2, 2014 to June 30, 2015, and up to 2,000 MCF/D for the KBS Central Facility from July 27, 2014 to October 31, 2014. The authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.
