**NOTE:**

**The RRC has secured a contractor to collect composite samples from all of the tanks included in the bid. The samples will be submitted to the RRC contract laboratory for NORM analysis on an expedited schedule. The results will be used to characterize the contents of each tank as either NORM or non-NORM.**

**The RRC will continue the current bid process with the Addendum #1 on the assumption that all of the contents of the tanks are non-NORM. If any of the analyses show otherwise the tank(s) in question may be excluded from the cleaning process after the bid is awarded or, at the discretion of the RRC, with a change order handled as NORM.**

**Questions:**

1. ... if a decision was made to remove any of the tanks from the bid due to them reading a little hot at the site visit?
  - **See the Note above**
2. Please identify how the RRC will proceed on this project, since the presence of NORM was identify during the site walk.
  - **See the Note above**
3. Should the RRC like for the contractors to bid as Non-NORM waste, please identify if the RRC will provide representative samples from both the solids and liquids of each tank.
  - **See the Note above**
4. Will there be an extension on the bid due date if needed?
  - **No, see the Note above**
5. Also, is there another addendum coming out on the Inland project in KilgoreTX? I thought I remembered a TRC Rep suggesting that there might be one added, before leaving the site visit.
  - **No addendum is anticipated.**
6. Has Inland Products/RRC already received approval from Topcat to accept the material?
  - **No, the disposal facility is the choice of the Contractor but must be a permitted facility agreed to by the RRC.**
7. Are there any Waste streams other than BS&W?
  - **No**

8. Will we be billing the disposal of the BS&W or will Topcat bill directly?
  - **The cost of disposal should be included in the costs for Line Item 1.**
9. What is the estimated volume, as I may be able to receive a volume discount based on this number?
  - **The estimated volume is presented in Line Item 1 of Addendum #1. The 4614 bbls. includes the estimated volume of the rinsate in Line Item 3 and the gauged tank volumes listed in Attachment B.**
10. What is the estimated Percent of solids in the waste stream?
  - **The tanks were “sticked” using a PVC pipe to touch the bottom. There was no delineation of solids or liquids.**
11. Is there any analytical available?
  - **Not at this time. The RRC will have TOX analyses available prior to the start of work in addition to the NORM analyses mentioned in the Note above.**
12. How many hours a day are we allowed to work and how many days a week can we work?
  - **Monday – Friday daylight hours with an option to work on Saturdays.**
