**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF COMSTOCK OIL & GAS, LP
FOR AN EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32 TO INCREASE VOLUME
LIMITATION IN THE EXISTING EMERGENCY FLARING EXCEPTIONS FOR THE
CARLSON/DONNELL TANK BATTERY AND CORTEZ TANK BATTERY FLARE
POINTS, EAGLEVILLE (EAGLE FORD-1) FIELD
LA SALLE AND MCMULLEN COUNTIES, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on August 28, 2015, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and proposal for decision, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Comstock Oil & Gas, LP is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the Carson/Donnell and Cortez Tank Batteries, Eagleville (Eagle Ford-1) Field, La Salle and McMullen Counties, Texas. Comstock Oil & Gas, LP is authorized to flare up to 760 thousand cubic feet (mcf) gas per day from the Carlson/Donnell Tank Battery (Permit No. 16653), and 3,000 mcf gas per day from the Cortez Tank Battery (Permit No. 16525), from April 1, 2014, through April 1, 2016. The authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

This authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms. The operator shall file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee for the facilities.
