FINAL ORDER

The captioned docket having been duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference in its Austin, Texas offices, the Commission adopts the following Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Glade Operating Co. (Glade) holds Operator Number 307603 and is the last known operator of record for the Christian, T. -B- (08189) Lease, Gregg County, Texas.
2. The P-5 of Glade is delinquent; it cannot lawfully operate in Texas.
3. KROG Partners, LLC (KROG) holds Operator Number 478189.
4. The P-5 of KROG is active and in good standing.
5. On or about June 25, 2015 KROG filed a completed form P-4 for transfer of the subject property from Glade as operator of record to KROG as operator of record and also submitted evidence that KROG held a good faith claim to operate the subject property.
6. The P-4 was signed by KROG's designated officer or agent, Robert Doviak.
7. On or about August 13, 2015, KROG submitted a letter explaining why it is unable to obtain the signature of Glade.

8. A letter dated August 20, 2015, was directed to Glade's address of record with notice that KROG sought designation as record operator of the subject property.
9. The letter notified Glade that it had the opportunity to protest transfer of the subject P-4, but Glade did not reply to the notice.
10. Glade has been the record operator of the subject property since April 2002; the property has zero (0) reported production from November 1999 through August 2015.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Resolution of this docket is a matter committed to the jurisdiction of the Railroad Commission of Texas. TEX. NAT. RES. CODE § 81.051
2. Glade Operating Co. has waived objection and hearing on transfer of the subject property to KROG Partners, LLC, as operator of record. 16 TEX. ADMIN. CODE § 3.58(a)(4)

Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED** that KROG Partners, LLC, Operator No. 478189 **HEREBY DESIGNATED** as Operator of Record for the Christian, T. -B- (08189) Lease, Gregg County, Texas.

It is further **ORDERED** that this order shall not be final and effective until 20 days after a party is notified of the Commission's order. A party is presumed to have been notified of the Commission's order three days after the date on which the notice is actually mailed. If a timely Motion for Rehearing is filed by any party at interest, this order shall not become final and effective until such motion is overruled, or if such motion is granted, this order shall be subject to further action by the Commission. Pursuant to TEX. GOV'T CODE §2001.146(e), the time allotted for Commission action on a Motion for Rehearing in this case, prior to its being overruled by operation of law, is hereby extended until 90 days from the date the parties are notified of the order.
