Newly Adopted Rule (1/2)

- Effective March 1, 2015
- Permit applications must include additional information:
 - Requested classification
 - Purpose of the pipeline or pipeline system
- Permit applications must include sworn statement



Newly Adopted Rule (2/2)

- If applicable:
 - documentation such as contract or tariff
 - other information requested by the Commission
- T-4 Permit revocable after hearing
- Applicant must acknowledge eminent domain provisions
