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Amend §3.28--deliverability testing requirements for gas wells

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Lewis Energy Group is proposing the following language to the rule amendment:

For clarity, consider the proposed language to Section 3.28(b)(1): After the initial deliverability test has been conducted, if an operator elects to perform a subsequent deliverability test for a well, the following schedule for well testing applies:

For clarity, consider removing "for example" from Page 1 Line #20.

For clarity, consider the proposed language to Section 3.28(b)(2) Notwithstanding the above provisions on frequency of testing, gas wells commingling liquid hydrocarbons before metering must comply with the testing provisions applicable to such wells. Gas wells that commingle liquid hydrocarbons (i.e., condensate) where metering occurs at each individual wellhead prior to commingling in a Tank, Separating Device or other facility, will comply with the provisions of this Chapter.
