OFFICE OF GENERAL COUNSEL-HEARINGS SECTION

GAS SERVICES PROTESTED

1. GUD No. 9958: Application of Longhorn Pipeline Company for approval of abandonment of service to the City of Benavides, Texas. The Commission unanimously approved the application.

SURFACE MINING AND RECLAMATION

2. Docket No. C10-0013-SC-32-E: Application by Texas Westmoreland Coal Co. for acceptance of replacement reclamation performance bond (self-bond with third-party guarantee by NRG Energy, Inc.) for Permit No. 32F, Jewett Mine, Leon, Limestone, and Freestone Counties, Texas. The Commission unanimously approved the application.
