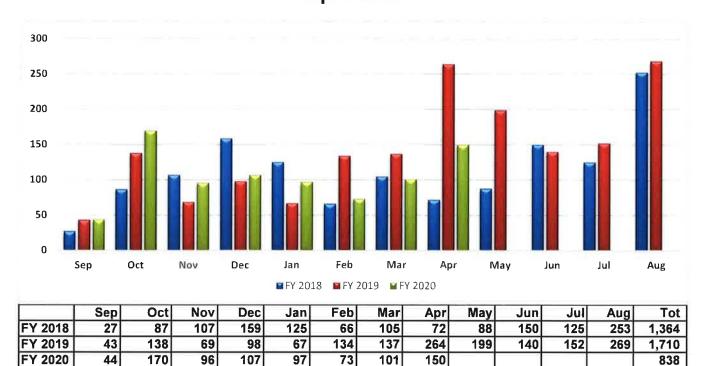

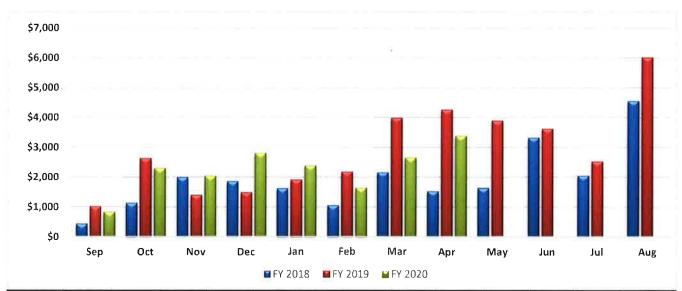

# State Managed Well Plugging Program Monthly Wells Plugged April 2020

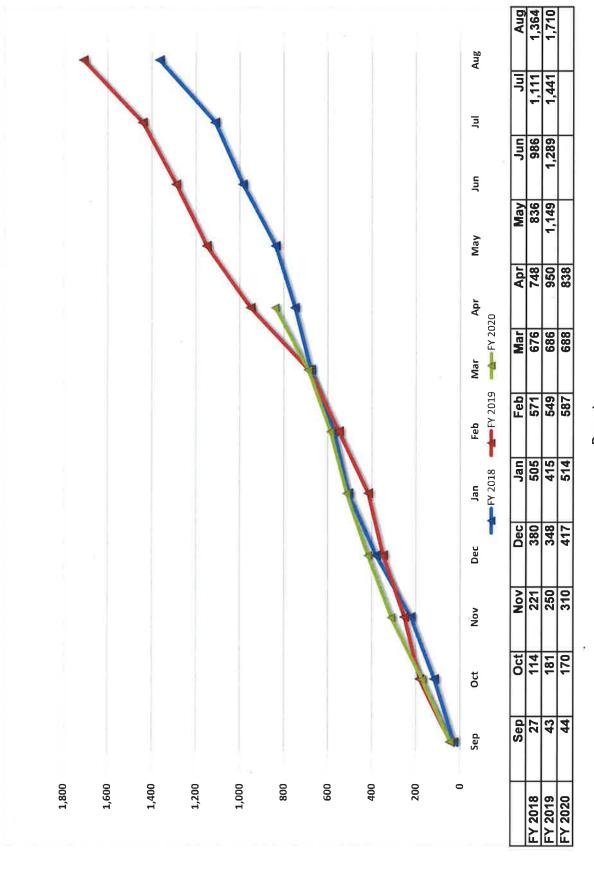


# State Managed Well Plugging Program Monthly Cost of Wells Plugged April 2020



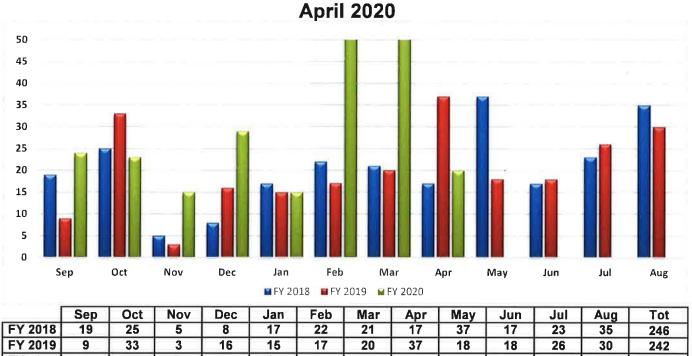

# State Managed Well Plugging Program Cumulative Wells Plugged April 2020



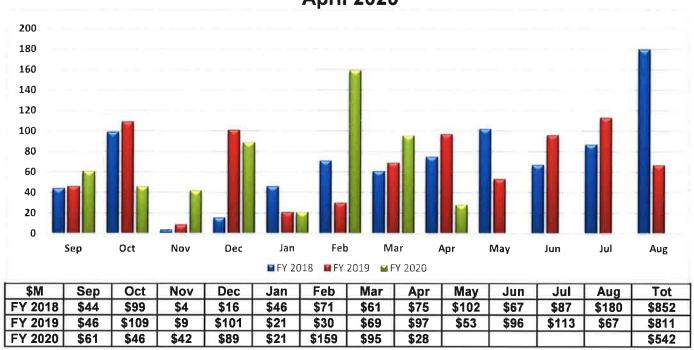

# **State Managed Well Plugging Program Monthly Salvage Operations**



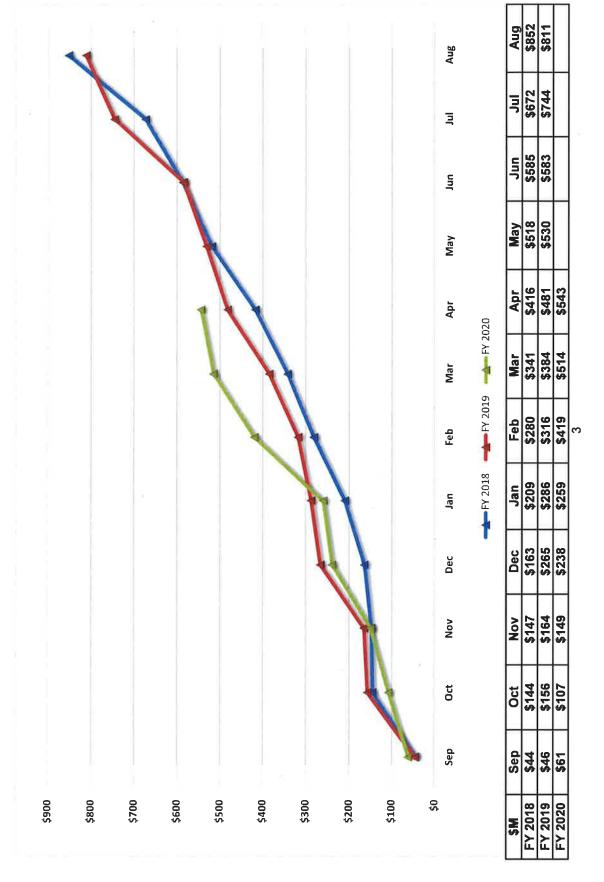
