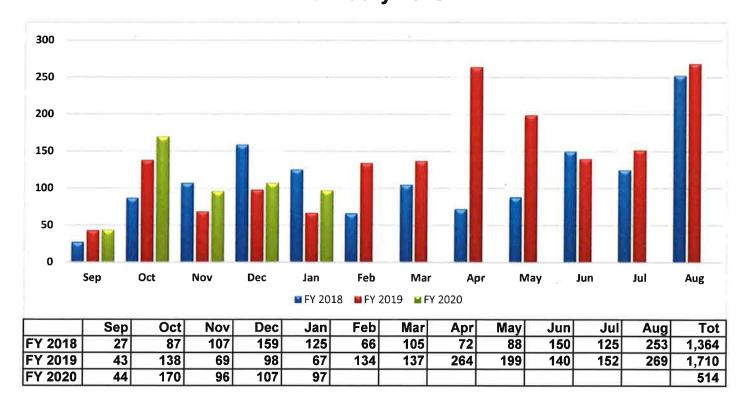

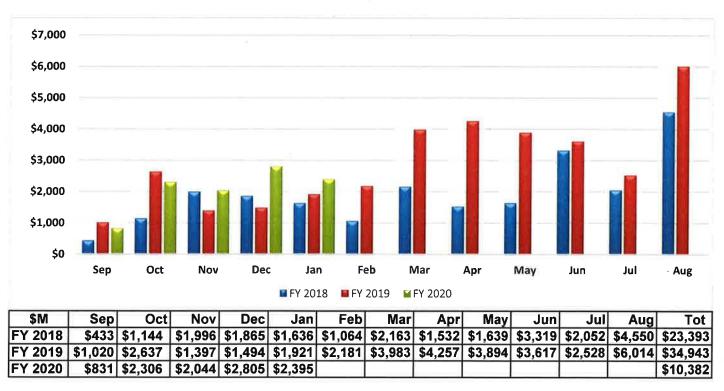

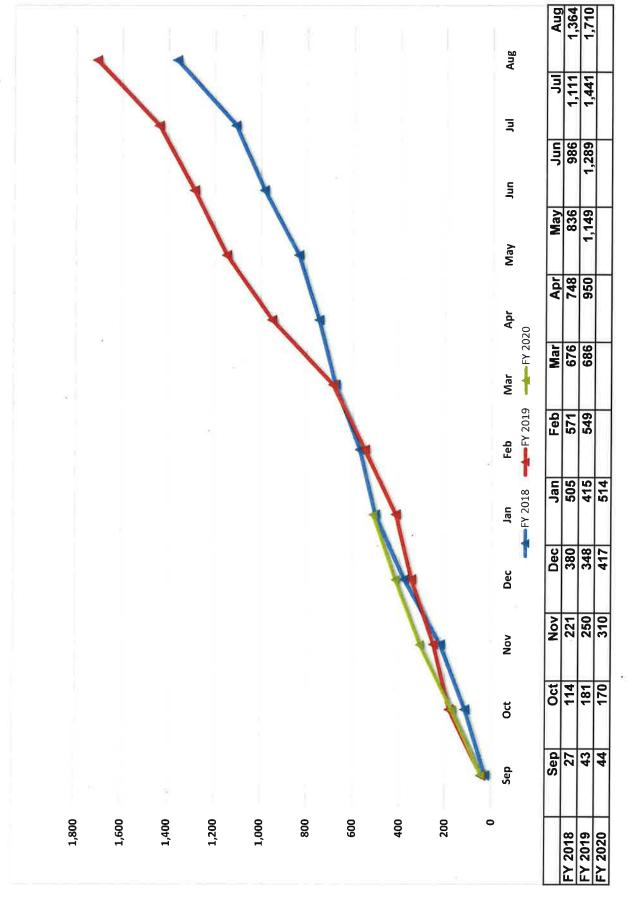
# State Managed Well Plugging Program Monthly Wells Plugged January 2020



# State Managed Well Plugging Program Monthly Cost of Wells Plugged January 2020

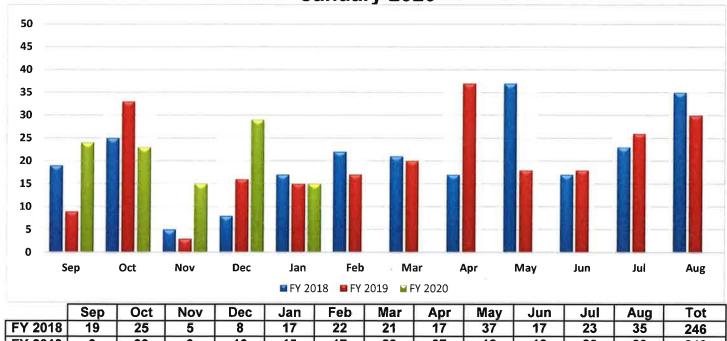


# State Managed Well Plugging Program Cumulative Wells Plugged January 2020



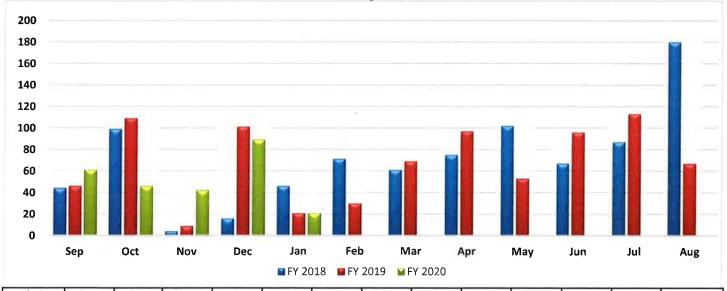

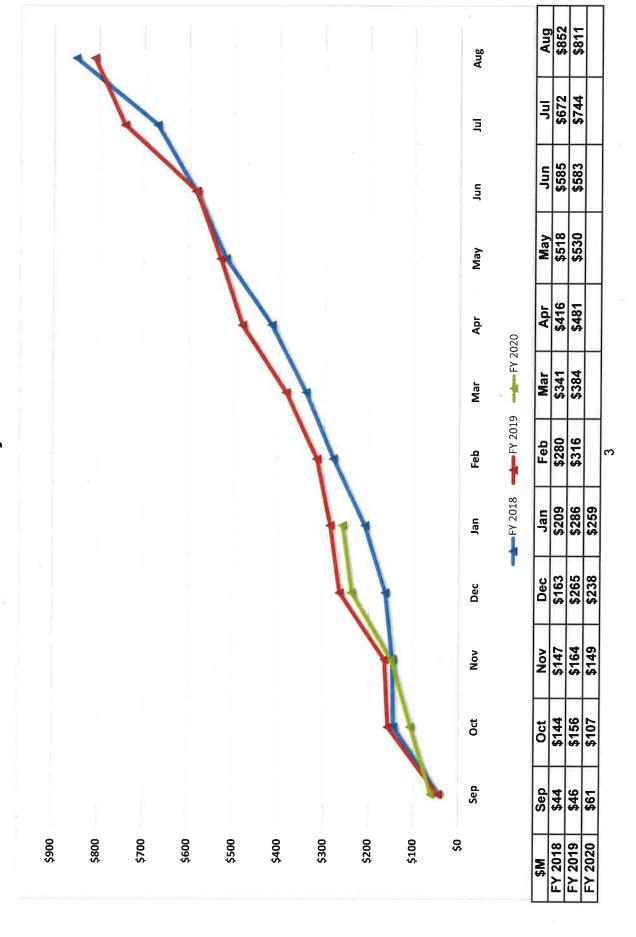
