ORDER NUNC PRO TUNC

**APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF SANCHEZ OIL AND GAS CORPORATION
FOR EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32 FOR THE
KRAWETZ RANCH A UNIT, WELL NO. A-1H
BRISCOE RANCH (EAGLEFORD) FIELD
ZAVALA COUNTY, TEXAS**

In conference at its office in Austin, Texas, the Railroad Commission of Texas took up for consideration its Final Order entered on August 6, 2013, the matter granting an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for Sanchez Oil and Gas Corporation, and its Krawetz Ranch A Unit, Well No. A-1H, in the Briscoe Ranch (Eagleford) Field, Zavala County, Texas. The Commission finds that, due to a clerical error, the Final Order entered August 6, 2013, did not state the correct applicant's name for the exception.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that the Final Order in Docket No. 01-0283005 be, and the same is hereby, amended *nunc pro tunc* so that the order contains the correct applicant's name and the order now reads as follows:

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Sanchez Oil and Gas Corporation is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the Krawetz Ranch A Unit (Lease No. 16068), Briscoe Ranch (Eagleford) Field, Zavala County, Texas. Sanchez Oil and Gas Corporation is authorized to flare casinghead gas as follows: up to 300 MCF/D for the Krawetz Ranch A Unit, Well No. A-1H, from June 3, 2013 to June 2, 2014. The authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms.

The operator shall file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee for each well.
