THE TAWAKANI (SMACKOVER) FIELD,  
KAUFMAN COUNTY, TEXAS.**

**FINAL ORDER**

The Railroad Commission of Texas has received and docketed this application under Statewide Rule 38(d)(3) to divide the Musgraves Unit into its separate tracts and makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. At least 21 day's notice of this application was given to all affected lessees and mineral interests owners.
2. There were no protests received opposing the dissolution.
3. On April 24, 1991, Wildco Resources, Inc. requested approval to dissolve the Musgraves Unit because the leases for the Musgraves Unit terminated due to cessation of production.
4. The Field rules for the Tawakani (Smackover) Field are:

933' / 1867' / 160 acres
5. On February 13, 1981, Allen Petroleum, Inc. filed a Form P-12 (Certificate of Pooling Authority) for the Musgraves Unit, Well No. 1, Tawakani (Smackover) Field, Kaufman County, Texas.
6. The 160 acre Musgraves Unit is comprised of the following tracts:

J. E. Musgraves, et al	87.755 acres
J. E. Musgraves, et al	51.052 acres
M. F. Quattlebaum	15.813 acres
H. M. Wooldridge	3.000 acres
Pauline Melton	2.380 acres
7. Production from Well No. 1 on the Musgraves Unit ceased in 1989.

8. On February 9, 1972 in Docket No. 5-61,364, the Commission determined that the Musgraves Unit contained 71.4 productive acres and the Quattlebaum Unit contained 121.1 productive acres.
9. In 1983, Well No. 1 on the Musgrave Unit "A" (01833) Lease, Tawakani (Smackover) Field, Kaufman County, Texas was reclassified as a disposal well. This well is operated by Dalvant Corporation.
10. In 1981, Well No. 1 on the J. E. Musgraves Lease (02276), Tawakani (Smackover) Field, Kaufman County, Texas was completed. This well is operated by Wildco Resources, Inc. on the Musgraves Unit.
11. In March 1990, the well on the Quattlebaum Unit was plugged and abandoned.
12. The Applicant wants to form a 160 acre unit containing productive acreage from the Musgraves and Quattlebaum Units. The proposed J. E. Musgraves Unit will be comprised of the following tracts:
 

Musgraves, et al	124.62 acres
Quattlebaum, et al	30.00 acres
Wooldridge	3.00 acres
Melton, et al	2.38 acres
13. The proposed J. E. Musgraves Unit will contain more productive acreage than the Musgraves Unit.
14. Well No. 1, Lease Id. No. 02776, will remain a regular location on the J. E. Musgraves Unit.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Proper notice of hearing was timely given to all persons legally entitled to notice.
2. All things have been done and have occurred to give the Commission jurisdiction in this matter.
3. Applicant has properly applied for approval of the dissolution of the Musgraves Unit in the Tawakani (Smackover) Field, Kaufman County, Texas.
4. Dissolution of the Musgraves Unit should be approved for the Tawakani (Smackover) Field, Kaufman County, Texas.
5. The granting of this application will not result in the circumvention of any applicable Commission rules.

Therefore, under authority of the Texas Natural Resources Code §85.202 and pursuant to

Statewide Rule 38(d)(3), it is hereby ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Wildco Resources, Inc. for dissolution of the Musgraves Unit into its component separate tracts with the rules of the Commission applicable to each separate tract be and is hereby **APPROVED** for the Tawakani (Smackover) Field, Kaufman County, Texas.
