



User's Guide to P-18's on microfilm

Background information about the microfilm

About the forms:

P-18:

P-18 is the form designation for the Skim Oil and Condensate Report. It is a report submitted to the RRC for an operator of a saltwater disposal well, or other disposal system, that states how much oil has been recovered or 'skimmed' from the wastewater received.

The P-18 microfilm ranges in year from 1968 to 2013. As of 2013, P-18's can be found online, through the P-18 profile:

Film / Image Organization:

The rolls of film are organized by year, usually 1-3 rolls per year.

Within each year grouping of rolls, the images are organized by District, then Month, then Alphabetically by Operator Name.

The end of each group of rolls for a year may contain LATES: P-18's which should have been included in previous years, but for various reasons were not.

The Late P-18's will also be organized by Year, District, Month, then alphabetically by Operator Name.
