APPLYING ON THE INTRASTATE TRANSPORTATION BY PIPELINE OF CRUDE PETROLEUM

The rate named in this tariff are for trunk line transportation and the gathering of crude petroleum by pipelines, subject to the Rules and Regulations published in Plains Pipeline L.P.'s Texas RRC No. 70, supplements thereto and reissues thereof.

In addition to the rules and regulations stated above, the applicable option associated with the rule will apply: Rule 31 – Measurement and Adjustments: Option 2 – No loss allowance.

TRUCK UNLOADING CHARGE: Crude petroleum unloaded from tank trucks into Carrier's facilities at Casselman, Midland County will be subject to a 7.00 cent per barrel unloading charge.

PUMPING CHARGE: A pumping charge of 7.02 cents per barrel will be assessed for deliveries to or from connecting pipelines at Midland, Texas.
