FINAL ORDER

**APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF PARSLEY ENERGY OPERATIONS, LLC. FOR
AN EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32 FOR THE RINGO 9 (18970) LEASE,
SPRABERRY (TREND AREA) FIELD, REAGAN COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numerated docket heard on December 21, 2017, the presiding Examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application submitted by Parsley Energy Operations, LLC is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Parsley Energy Operations, LLC is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the Ringo 9 (18970) Lease, Spraberry (Trend Area) Field, Reagan County, Texas. Parsley is authorized to flare a maximum volume of 1,500 MCF per day (45,000 mcf/Month) of casinghead gas from the Ringo 9 (18970) Lease, effective January 1, 2018 through January 1, 2020. The authority is granted provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms. Parsley Energy Operations, LLC shall simultaneously file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet, and the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.

Pursuant to §2001.144(a)(4)(A), of the Texas Government Code, and the agreement of the applicant, this Final Order is effective when a Master Order relating to this Final Order is signed.
