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**APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF MATADOR PRODUCTION COMPANY FOR AN EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32 TO FLARE GAS FROM THE FALLS CITY TB (DRILLING PERMIT NOS. 822567 AND 822730), EAGLEVILLE (EAGLE FORD-2) FIELD, KARNES COUNTY, TEXAS.**

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**FINAL ORDER**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numerated docket heard on September 12, 2018, the presiding Examiners have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required that the proposed application submitted by Matador Production Company is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and any exceptions and replies thereto, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Matador Production Company is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 to flare 1500MCF/D of Casinghead gas from the Falls City TB (Drilling Permit Nos. 822567 and 822730), Eagleville (Eagle Ford-2) Field, Karnes County, Texas. Matador seeks two-year authority to flare up to 1500 MCF/D of Casinghead gas from October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2020.

The authority is granted provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms. Matador Production Company shall simultaneously file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet, and the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee.

**Pursuant to §2001.144(a)(4)(A), of the Texas Government Code, and the agreement of the applicant, this Final Order is effective when a Master Order relating to this Final Order is signed.**
