**APPROVING APPLICATION OF ANADARKO E&P ONSHORE LLC (020528) FOR AN EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32 FOR VARIOUS FLARE POINTS IN THE SANDBAR (BONE SPRING) FIELD, LOVING, REEVES AND WARD COUNTIES, TEXAS**

**FINAL ORDER**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on November 1, 2018, the presiding Technical Examiner and Administrative Law Judge (collectively the "Examiners") have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application of Anadarko E&P Onshore LLC, is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Anadarko E&P Onshore LLC is hereby granted exceptions, to flare low pressure casinghead ("flash") gas from the flare points listed in Appendix A, in the Phantom (Wolfcamp) Field, Loving, Reeves and Ward Counties, Texas.

This authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms. The operator shall file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee for each flare point.

Pursuant to §2001.144(a)(4)(A), of the Texas Government Code, and the agreement of the applicant on the record, the parties have waived right to file a Motion for Rehearing and this Final Order is final and effective on the date the Master Order relating to this Final Order is signed.
