APPLICATION OF HALCON OPERATING CO., INC. (344412) FOR AN EXCEPTION TO STATEWIDE RULE 32 FOR THE BAILEY SALES POINT, (FLARE PERMIT NO. 34885), ELIZABETH SALES POINT, (FLARE PERMIT NO. 34886), SUMMIT BATTERY, (FLARE PERMIT NO. 34383), SEALY RANCH 5902H AND (FLARE PERMIT NO. 34883), PHANTOM (WOLFCAMP) FIELD, WOLFBONE (TREND AREA) FIELD, AND HOEFS T-K (WOLFCAMP) FIELD, PECOS, REEVES, AND WRD COUNTIES, TEXAS

FINAL ORDER

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on December 18, 2018, the Technical Examiner and Administrative Law Judge (collectively "Examiners") have made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the Examiners' report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that Halcon Operating Co., Inc. is hereby granted an exception to Statewide Rule 32 for the Bailey Sales Point (Flare Permit No. 34885), Elizabeth Sales Point (Flare Point No. 34886), Summit Battery (Flare Permit No. 34383), Phantom (Wolfcamp) Field, Wolfbone (Trend Area) Field, and Hoefs T-K (Wolfcamp) Field, in Pecos, Reeves, and Ward Counties, Texas, for following time periods and rates:

Flare Point	Volume / MCF per day	Duration
Bailey Sales	15,000	August 16, 2018 – August 15, 2020
Elizabeth Sales	15,000	August 16, 2018 – August 15, 2020
Summit Battery	5,000	September 6, 2018 – September 5, 2020

The authority is granted, provided all production is reported on the appropriate Commission forms. The operator shall file the Statewide Rule 32 Exception Data Sheet and, shall file at the same time, the appropriate Commission required administrative Statewide Rule 32 Exception gas flaring fee for the facility.

Pursuant to §2001.144(a)(4)(A), of the Texas Government Code, and the consent of the applicant, the Final Order is final and effective when a Master Order relating to this Final Order is signed.
