APPLICATION OF PHILLIPS 66 PIPELINE, LLC (663865) FOR AUTHORITY PURSUANT TO STATEWIDE RULE 97 FOR A NEW PERMIT TO CREATE, OPERATE, AND MAINTAIN AN UNDERGROUND GAS STORAGE FACILITY ON THE CLEMENS SALT DOME B (26843) LEASE, WELL NO. 7, CLEMENS, NE (FRIO B) FIELD, BRAZORIA COUNTY, TEXAS

FINAL ORDER

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on June 3, 2019, the presiding examiners have made and filed a report an examiners' report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after due consideration of the examiners' report and recommendation and the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Phillips 66 Pipeline LLC (663865) to create, operate and maintain a new underground gas storage facility for the Clemens Salt Dome B (26843) Lease, Well 7, Clemens, NE (Frio B) Field, Brazoria County, Texas, is hereby **APPROVED**. The Commission's Technical Permitting Section shall issue the permit(s) pursuant to the conditions and requirements of Statewide Rule 97. Phillips 66 Pipeline LLC shall comply with all applicable rules and safety standards adopted by the Commission pursuant to Statewide Rule 97.

Pursuant to § 2001.144(a)(4)(A), of the Texas Government Code, and by agreement of the parties in writing or on the record, **the parties have waived right to file a Motion for Rehearing and this Final Order is final and effective on the date the Master Order relating to the Final Order is signed.**
